Sand Hutton Church of England Primary School

An attractive small rural school situated in Sand Hutton village which is part of a confederation with Warthill Primary School. The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief. It seeks to develop the full potential of all children in a caring environment which values all its members.

The school serves a wide area and children from Gate Helmsley, Upper Helmsley, Buttercrambe, Harton, Flaxton, Bossall, Claxton, Flaxton and outlying farms travel to school by bus.

The pupils, aged 4-11 years, are organised into three classes; Infants (Reception; Year 1 & Year 2) Lower Juniors (Years 3 & 4) and Upper Juniors (Years 5 & 6).

The school has a hall used for assemblies, physical education and meals as well as its own kitchen. Outside there are large playing fields, an early years play area and a large playground. There is also a wildlife area.
