APM23/3 Annual Report:

- During the year we welcomed two new councillors from Sand Hutton making a total of 6 councillors for the Parish Council.
- We have viewed, studied and commented on several planning applications over the course of the year. These comments based on local knowledge are sent to Ryedale Council which was the decision making body.
- Various road defects have been reported and rectified.
- Where possible the street lighting will be changed to a more efficient LED form of illumination which will be substantially cheaper to run. (Not all of the lamp posts will accept the new fittings.)
- In Claxton the issue of vehicle speeding is being addressed by the introduction of white gates at the entrance to the village, and a community speed watch programme has been under way, with offenders being reported to the police for further action.
- Saturday social events have taken place in the village hall, which have been well attended.
- The litter pick this spring was well attended, and particularly encouraging was the number of children involved in helping.
- The Parish Council website is established and working.
- Most importantly I would like to thank the Parish Council team and all those who voluntarily give their time to make our parish a better place to live in.
